

Dress attire policy:

Etiquette and Attire: The intent of the dress code is to make our environment more enjoyable and help sustain the quality of membership and standard of excellence upon which Horseshoe Bay Resort and Club was established.

Yacht Club, Y Bar, and Cap Rock Clubhouse: Country Club casual wear includes cocktail attire, dress shirts, sport shirts (collared shirts), dress pants/slacks, dress shorts (golf shorts, khaki shorts, Bermuda shorts) and stylish jeans. Appropriate dress shoes are required at all times. Men are required to wear closed shoes. Flip flops are not acceptable for men or women. Golf/tennis hats may only be worn in the dining areas until 5:00 PM. Ladies may wear fashion hats in the evening while hats of any kind are not permitted for men. Not Allowed—tennis outfits, tennis shoes, flip flops, tank tops, cut-offs, short shorts, tee shirts, swim attire, yoga pants and sweat suits are not acceptable attire.

Golf Courses and Facilities: Collared shirts are required. No t-shirts or denim allowed. Soft spikes only. Tennis shoes are permitted.

Paseo Fitness Center: All participants are asked to wear appropriate athletic clothing while working out or participating in activities. Closed-toed shoes, shirts, and athletic bottoms are required.

Yacht Club Pool, Beach, and Cap Rock Pool: Appropriate bathing suits and swim attire including swim trunks, one and two-piece ladies bathing suits. Overly revealing swim attire is not permitted.
