

Temporary License Training Time Extension HB 1197 by Paul/SB 519 by Creighton

Background

Temporary licenses are designed for people who are considering a career change to an insurance agent. Many people attempt this transition in their careers while still working in another full-time job in order to provide for themselves or their families. As many who discover while changing careers, completing 40 hours of training in 14 days can be difficult while working a 40-hour work week.

Purpose of HB 1197/SB 519

This bill would increase from 14 to 30 days the time a temporary license applicant has to complete the required 40-hour training.
